Please note the following as these are items that will be needed for the upcoming year:

- **First:** Please send in two wallet size pictures of your child. I will be making cards for each child with these pictures. These cards will be used as a place holder for work the child takes from a shelf. These cards will also help each child, especially the younger ones, to recognize their names.
- **Second:** Please send in a baby picture of your child (less than one year old). These picture will be used for a poster and the children will be guessing who each baby is.

- **Third:** Your child's birthday will be celebrated on his/her actual birthday. If it is during the weekend or vacation time, it will be celebrated the Friday before. To help us in celebrating, please send in a picture for each year of your child's life along with a short story telling us about his/her favorite toys, food, and general information which can be read in class. These should be given at the beginning of the year to ensure that we have them on hand for their birthday celebration.

Please feel free to have your child decorate the enclosed snack bag. They must bring it to school each morning filled with one morning snack.

There is also a supply list enclosed with this mailing, listing items which are needed for our classroom. Thank you for helping our class with these items. This will greatly help to defray the cost of everyday items used.
